
Motorcyclist Killed in Bossier City Multi-Vehicle Crash

Printable toolkit: action steps, evidence checklist, and insurer-proof gaps for Louisiana families.

First 72 Hours: Family Checklist

- Write down the crash location, time, and who responded.
- Ask for the crash report number and investigator contact.
- Identify nearby cameras and request video preservation quickly.
- Preserve the motorcycle, helmet, and gear; avoid repairs or salvage.
- Save photos, texts, and call logs that help build a timeline.
- Do not sign releases or give recorded statements until you understand the scope.

Records to Request and Preserve

Record	Why it matters
Crash report + diagram	The baseline narrative, involved parties, and cited violations.
911 audio + CAD log	Independent timestamps and what was reported in real time.
Scene photos/video	Damage paths, debris field, lane positions, and sight lines.
Tow/storage paperwork	Where the vehicles went and who controls access to them.

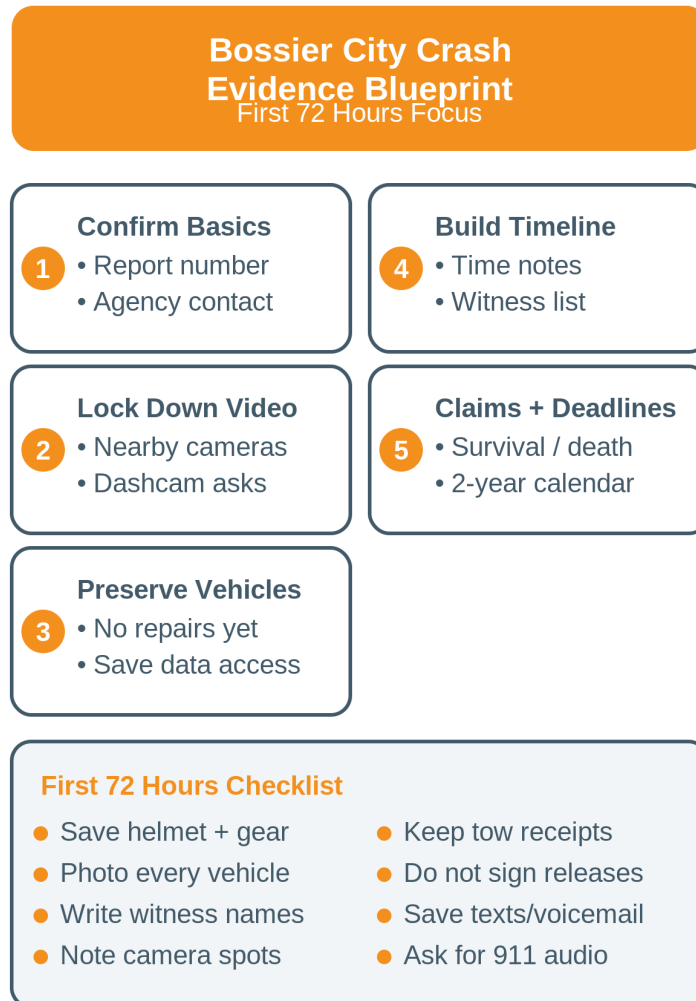
Common Insurance Pressure Points

- A fast call asking for a recorded statement before the family has documents.
- A quick settlement offer tied to a broad release.
- A dispute about sequence, speed, or right-of-way in multi-vehicle crashes.
- A push to move or dispose of vehicles before the evidence is documented.
