Fast Answer

There is no fixed settlement amount. Value usually turns on fault, available coverage, and how well the damages are documented.

The goal is to build a clean, trial-ready file so the claim is priced on proof instead of guesses.

What Moves A Settlement Up Or Down

- Clear liability supported by photos, witness details, and a consistent timeline.
- Documented medical care and symptoms that match the crash mechanics.
- Work impact backed by employer notes and time records, not just memory.
- Property damage proof, including estimates, parts lists, and total-loss paperwork.
- Gaps in care explained with dates and a simple reason (travel, referral wait, cost).
- Comparative fault issues identified early, because fault can reduce or bar recovery.

Evidence Checklist (Bring This To Your Call)

- Crash report number (or the agency and date if you do not have it yet).
- Photos or video of vehicles, road scene, traffic signs, and visible injuries.
- Names and phone numbers for witnesses and responding officers, if known.
- Medical visit dates, provider names, and any work restrictions or notes.
- Repair estimate or total-loss paperwork, towing, rental, and related receipts.
- A short timeline: what happened, where you were hit, and what changed after.

Use these steps to

- 1 Build A Timeline**
Build a timeline of events and symptoms
- 2 Stay Consistent**
Get consistent medical care and follow-ups
- 3 Lock In Liability**
Photos, witness names, and crash report info
- 4 Track Your Losses**
Work notes, receipts, and repair estimates
- 5 Preserve Proof**
Texts, ride logs, and daily limits notes

First 72 Hours Checklist

- Take wide + close photos of all vehicles
- Save tow + rental paperwork and receipts
- Write a pain + work impact journal entry
- Get witness contacts before memories fade
- Request crash report number and agency

Low impact, low injury	Photos, angles, repair notes pain journal line
No ambulance, not hurt	Early care + symptom log work impact notes
Gaps in treatment	Explain gaps + keep dates follow plan notes
Pre-existing issues	Baseline records + new limits consistent story
You share fault 51% or more	Scene facts + witness proof timeline matches
