## Fast Facts to Write Down

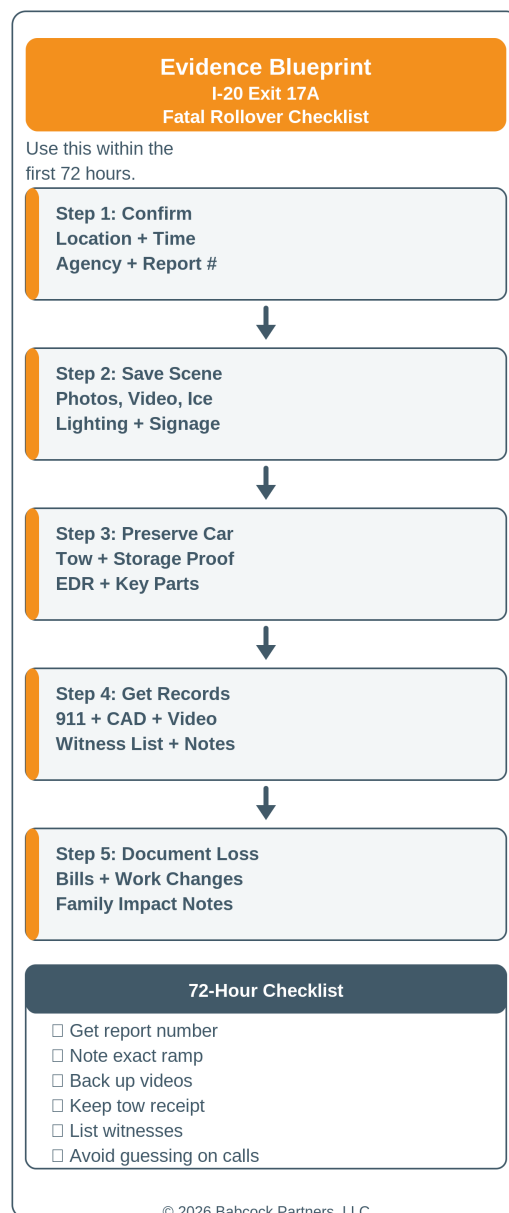

## First 72 Hours: Do This First

- Back up any photos or video from the scene, including dashcam clips.
- Write down names and phone numbers for witnesses and first responders you spoke with.
- Keep towing and storage receipts, and do not authorize repairs or disposal until you get advice.
- Start a call log: who called, what they asked for, and what you provided.
